4.4	BASKETBALL: The sports achievement in the event conducted by Basket Ball Federation of India or its affiliated units after 28.03.2015 shall not be considered for the recruitment purpose. However, the certificates issued by the International federation for recognized sports achievement in the Game of Basket Ball will be considered.”																														
4.5	KABADDI- Sportspersons should not be more than 80 kg at the time of attending the Trials.																														
4.6	For the norms mentioned above, only Senior National & Junior National Championships shall be taken into consideration. Rural meets, Festival meets & other similar Tournaments shall not be considered.																														
4.7	For recruitment of Sports Persons, on the basis of sports achievements in Junior National Championships, the age groups as mentioned below shall only be considered.																														
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4.8	Explanatory Note: All the championships mentioned above should have been conducted under the aegis of recognized International/National/State Sports Federation and also recognized by Railway Sports Promotion Board (RSPB).																														
4.9	PERIOD OF RECKONING SPORTS ACHIEVEMENT: The sports achievements shall be in the current / or immediate previous two financial years and sports persons shall be an active player. For this purpose, the period shall be counted from the date of receipt of application. Explanatory Note: (i) The sports achievements on or after 01.04.2014 shall only be considered for this recruitment. (ii) For validity of sports achievement, the concluding day of the Championship / event shall be taken into account.																														
5.0	PROCEDURE FOR RECRUITMENT : The candidates, who apply in response to this notification and are found eligible for consideration for appointment against sports quota, will be assessed based on their performance during Trial & Interview as detailed.																														
5.1	Selection will consist of Trial followed by a Personal Interview. Only candidates who fulfill the Eligibility Criteria will be subjected to the selection process. Candidates are required to bring their original certificates when they are called for the selection process.																														
5.2	Trials of the candidate shall be conducted to assess the sports performance and suitability for Railway / Unit team as well as Indian Railways Team.

6.0	MEDICAL EXAMINATION :		
	Selected candidates will have to undergo medical examination and found fit for the medical classification prescribed for the post.		
7.0	FEE :		
7.1	A fee of Rs. 500/- must be paid only through Demand Draft / Indian Postal Order drawn in favour of FA&CAO/ICF payable at Chennai.		
7.2	i) Rs. 250/- for SC/ST/Ex-servicemen /Minorities and Economic Backward Classes, which will be refunded to those who actually appear for the selection.		
	ii) While applying, the candidates claiming fee exemption must submit necessary certificates i.e. SC/ST/OBC/Ex-servicemen, in the format as prescribed in the Central Government order.		
	iii) If proof is not enclosed such candidates will be considered as Unreserved candidates, subject to payment of Rs. 500/- towards the fee.		
7.3	Candidates must write their name, full address at the space provided in the

8.0	TRAINING : In case, the candidates are found suitable and are appointed in the Railways they have to undergo training for the period prescribed for the particular post in which they will be offered appointment, in case training is necessary for the particular post.
9.0	HOW TO APPLY :
9.1	If a candidate is applying for more than one Game, then he should submit separate application for each of the Game.
9.2	Applications should be strictly in the prescribed format as appended, shall be filled in A-4 size GSM Bond paper.

9.4	One passport size photograph should be pasted on the application form at the space specified.
9.5	Along with the filled-in application form an IPO or Demand Draft for an amount of Rs.500/- (or) Rs. 250/- (as applicable) should be enclosed.
9.6	Self-Attested photocopies of the following documents should be enclosed. i) Proof of Educational Qualification/Technical Qualification/Typing qualification (if any). ii) Proof of Date of Birth {any one of Birth Certificate, Standard X - TC, Matric mark list}. iii) Transfer Certificate /School Leaving Certificate (last studied). iv) SC/ST/OBC certificate in the format as prescribed in the Central Government order, if required. v) Department / Government service candidates must enclose a No Objection Certificate from the employer. vi) Necessary testimonials concerning the Sports activities up to the date of application. vii) Certificates in language other than English or Hindi should be accompanied by an attested translation in English / Hindi.
9.7	The candidates should bring all the original certificates when they are called to appear for the Trial / Interview.
9.8	The application should be sent along with the above enclosures, duly self-attested . On top of the envelope " Application for Sports Recruitment (Open Advertisement) " should be written in Block letters and write the category applied for. 10.0	GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS TO CANDIDATES :
10.1	The candidates applying for the post should ensure that they fulfil the eligibility conditions at the time of submission of applications.
10.2	The specific position played in the particular Game / Event, if applicable,

	should be mentioned without fail.
10.3	The decision of ICF in all matters relating to eligibility, acceptance or rejection of the application, issue of free rail passes, penalty for false information, mode of selection, conduct of Interview/ Trial, selection, allotment of post to selected candidates etc. will be final and binding on the candidates.
10.4	ICF administration reserves the right to alter the stages of recruitment of cancel part or whole or any recruitment process at any stage without assigning any reason.
10.5	The candidate should attend the Trial at the date, time & venue specified by ICF administration and any request for change of date, time & venue will not be entertained.
10.6	The candidate will have to make their own arrangements for their stay at Chennai or the place indicated for a few days while attending Trial / Interview. No TA/DA/ Accommodation will be given for appearing in the selection/ Trial/ interview.
10.7	As the date of Trials has been fixed, candidates who are applying in response to this notification should be in readiness to appear before the Trial committee on the date of Trials. Eligible candidates will be intimated through email and SMS only.
10.8	Candidates may note that submitting fake / forged documents or any information furnished being found false or incorrect, his candidature / application is liable to be cancelled / terminated without any notice at any stage i.e. Trial / Interview / Empanelment / Appointment.
