Suresh Gyan Vihar University is a Self-Financed University established by Govt. of Rajasthan under Section 2(f) of UGC Act 1956 vide Suresh Gyan Vihar University, Jaipur Act 2008 which came into existence in the year 2008, Suresh Gyan Vihar University comprises of three campuses sprawled across an area of 130 acres at Jaipur, the capital of Rajasthan.

We first ventured in imparting technical education with the inception of Gyan Vihar School of Engineering & Technology in the year 2000. The school offers an extensive choice of undergraduate and postgraduate programs in engineering viz; Electronics & Communication, Mechanical Engineering, Computer Science, Information & Technology, Electrical Engineering, Civil Engineering, Software Engineering, Digital Wireless Communication Engineering, Power System, Manufacturing & Industrial Engineering, and Energy Engineering. Gyan Vihar School of Pharmacy, another constituent college of ours is one of the finest pharmacy colleges in the country. With Gyan Vihar School of Hotel management we have been trying to set a benchmark for academia and industry by striving to nurture enterprising hotel management graduates. Freeship at Suresh Gyan Vihar University

In a world afflicted by inequity, abandoned of hope and devoid of a sense of justice, Suresh Gyan Vihar University is striving to create platforms, build bridges and forge crucibles for the underprivileged. What others deem impracticable, terming the economics of it onerous and the effort inefficient, is very essential to the moral philosophy of Suresh Gyan Vihar University. To say that we have obligations to the society and to term it a deontological endeavor would still not be enough to describe the passion and zeal for education that illuminates our hearts here at Suresh Gyan Vihar University. A dream drives us, the dream to take education to every doorstep, the dream to play a part in transforming India, the dream to nurture individuals into mindful and thoughtful adults; irrespective of their ability to bear the cost of education.

Here we are, taking a small human step in the direction of this dream we harbor. We announce scholarships worth Rs 10 Crore for the upcoming session (2017-18). Considering the financial limitations, we have decided to award scholarships on the basis of merit. The entire cost of education for all selected students will entirely be borne by the University. Selected students will thus have no monetary obligation towards the University. The freeships are to be awarded under the following heads.

Category - A

100 meritorious students will be selected each year based on their academic performance.

For Undergraduate Programs:

Students will have to enroll and subsequently appear for GVSAT. Gyan Vihar Scholastic Aptitude Test (GVSAT) is conducted by SGVU annually as the eligibility test for various undergraduate programs. Students having successfully passed 10+2 examinations are eligible to appear for GVSAT. **Students who perform exceptionally well in GVSAT and the subsequent interview and having secured 85% or more marks in 10+2 across a spectrum of recognised boards will be eligible to be awarded freeship for the Undergraduate Programs they have applied in.** On a weighted average pattern, the score of GVSAT will hold 40% weightage; the marks in 10+2 will hold another 50% weightage and the interview will be worth 10%. All the weighted average scores will be compiled in a merit list and the top 70 scorers will be awarded the freeship.



For Postgraduate Programs:

Students who perform exceptionally well in GVSAT, the subsequent interview and having secured 75% or more marks in undergraduate programs across a spectrum of disciplines will be eligible to be awarded freeship for the Postgraduate Programs they have applied in. On a weighted average pattern, the score of GVSAT will hold 40% weightage, the marks in Undergraduate program will hold another 50% weightage and the interview will be worth 10%. All the weighted average scores will be compiled in a merit list and the top 30 scorers will be awarded the freeship.

'How' and 'When'

The freeship scheme will be "rolling" in nature and the award will shift to deserving candidates in subsequent years based on their performance in University Examinations. Only the students scoring SGPA above 7.5 in each semester and meeting the criterion of 75% attendance per semester with no backs will continue to reap the benefits of the freeship scheme. The freeship concerns the academic cost of the course only. Selected students will continue paying accommodation fees, if they opt for in-campus accommodation.

GVSAT will be organized in the month of January and then again in April and shall have no registration or examination fees. Shortlisted students shall be called for interviews in the second week of April 2017 and the merit list for the freeship scheme shall come out in the first week of May 2017. The selected students will be communicated and asked to report to the University for due documentation in the third week of May 2017.

Apart from the freeship on offer those on the waitlist will stand a chance to win scholarships ranging from Rs. 5000 to Rs. 10000.

Category-B

Students who are underprivileged and financially unsound will also be awarded freeship. Out of all interested candidates 100 passionate young men and women will be handpicked after an interview. The selected students will not have to bear either the academic cost of the program or the accommodation fees.



'How' and 'When'

We want to play our part in building a world that offers equal opportunities to all. We will spearhead a massive campaign to invite applications from underprivileged (economically backward) and passionate students from the state of Rajasthan. Communication will be sent to all private and state owned schools across all the districts in Rajasthan, exhorting their Principals to nominate two students: a boy and a girl each for our freeship scheme. Applications shall be invited from all 33 districts of Rajasthan. A panel of academicians shall then shortlist 150 students to be called for interview at Suresh Gyan Vihar University in the month of April 2017. The interviews shall look out for passionate and energetic candidates. A final list of 100 selected students shall be released in the first week of May 2017 and the selected students will be asked to report to the University for due documentation in the third week of May 2017. The University will bear the combined cost of study and accommodation of selected students for the entire duration of the course.

Apart from the freeship on offer those on the waitlist will stand a chance to win scholarships ranging from Rs. 5000 to Rs. 10000.

Category-C

Leaders of tomorrow.

We want to create a synergic relationship between the University and the Industry. We want to build an atmosphere where individuals with multifarious inclinations, affinities and talents are identified, groomed and nurtured to truly become the Leaders of Tomorrow. The University plans on selecting students through various platforms which will be specifically designed to unearth the unique aptitudes and talents of bright young students. The following competitions will be held to select 100 bright young students who will be awarded 100 percent freeship for their respective courses.

Exceptional talents who aren't considered to be academically gifted in a 'conventional' sense go on to defy all odds and stigmas to emerge as the leaders





of tomorrow. The world which starts of being unkind to such talents ends up benefitting the most from their talents and achievements. We want to ease their way out. We want to let such individuals know that their talents will no longer go unnoticed and that they deserve every bit of respect and adulation from the academic milieu as their more academically inclined peers. It is a very large canvas to work on and thus presents a huge opportunity. We along with partners from the media and from India Inc. will be holding competitions, talent hunts, scouting campaigns and talent exhibits to make sure that those with the gift for the spectacular don't miss out on a sound education. The campaign to invite applicants will start in the month of January 2017 and onwards we shall invite applicants from all quarters for competitions like:

- **Codethon:** Coding competition to select the brightest young coders for a world which is increasingly becoming digital. The ablest minds will be awarded 100 percent freeship for the programs of their interest.
- **Get Quizzical:** Answering difficult questions is an art difficult to master. The best of minds will be identified and awarded with freeship across courses.
- Model making/Circuit Making Competition: Making meaningful mechanical
 and electrical contraptions/devices/circuits in a laboratory setting. The
 engineers of tomorrow have to be identified and groomed at the earliest
 possible. Those selected will be eligible for 100 percent freeship in programs
 of their interest.
- **Spelling Bee:** Exceptional young men and women with a flair for language will be identified and awarded freeship.
- B-plan competition: The business leaders and game changers of tomorrow.
 The ones with the most exciting B-plans will be awarded freeship for the programs of their interest. They will also be mentored during the course of their studies.
- **Social Venture Competition:** Encouraging youngsters to come up with sustainable and viable social solutions. The deserving social entrepreneurs will be awarded freeship in the programs of their interest.
- **Turn Coat:** Stirring up orators. The best public speakers would be eligible for freeship in the programs of their interest.
- **Essay Writing Competition:** Bringing out the best of literary talent. The best writers would be eligible for freeship in the program of their interest.
- Radio Podcast: A competition where we will be inviting 2-minute audio





bulletins of international news. The best presenters will be eligible to 100 percent freeship in the programs of their interest.

- Art Wars: To bring out the artists and tech savvy designers amongst our youngsters. Exceptional performers will be eligible for 100 percent freeship in the programs of their interest.
- Ideas of tomorrow: Encouraging students to come forward with innovative scientific ideas. The best ones will be selected for 100 percent freeship in the programs of their interest.
- Policy Advocacy and Research
- Performing Arts Talent Exhibit
- Quest for gold: Athletes and sportsperson who hold the promise of bringing laurels at national and International level shall also be selected.

'How' and 'When'

These competitions will be held during the following months at Suresh Gyan Vihar University. The results shall be announced in the first week of May 2017 and the 100 selected students will be asked to report for due documentation in the third week of May 2017.

Apart from the freeship on offer those on the waitlist will stand a chance to win scholarships ranging from Rs. 5000 to Rs. 10000.

GVSAT

The purpose of any exam should be to gauge the depth of knowledge acquired by the subject who appears for the said examination. 'Knowledge' here is the key. Epistemological processes have always been temporal. The scope, meaning and definition of knowledge along with its theory has changed with time. The world we live in digitizes and incessantly divides knowledge into Nano-packets of information. These packets are marketed and consumed in a market economy. In such circumstances it becomes all the more difficult to separate the 'wise' candidates from voracious consumers of information packets. And thus the onus is on the academician to devise methods which can identify knowledge seekers and differentiate them from those to whom knowledge is nothing more than a marketable commodity. We want to be that difference. Suresh Gyan Vihar University wants to become a part of the journey of those who aspire to bring about a net positive change in the society. We want to pick students who feel passionate about their area of interest, are inclined towards the application part



of knowledge and have a strong moral compass. The test thus has to be different from all run-of-the-mill tests which are conducted year in and year out. We have come up with GVSAT or the Gyan Vihar Scholastic Aptitude Test for granting admissions to Suresh Gyan Vihar University.

GVSAT shall comprise of two components:

General aptitude test: We shall test the students on the level of proficiency in language, verbal and nonverbal reasoning skills and general awareness. Also, Ethical aptitude and sensitivity on issues which concern humanity.

Scholastic Aptitude: The second paper shall test the students on subject specific knowledge depending on their stream of study. (Viz. Arts, Science, Commerce, etc.)

Both papers shall have 50 questions and each question shall carry equal weightage. The time duration shall be 100 minutes. A student thus has to go through 100 problems ranging from climate change and corruption to molecular chemistry and electromagnetism in a space of 100 minutes. Students across streams and disciplines can appear for the test. The test shall be conducted for all academic levels above class 12 for admission in various undergraduate and postgraduate courses. Performance in GVSAT combined with marks secured in 10+2 exam will help students gain access to the freeship scheme of Suresh Gyanvihar University. To encourage a different pattern of entrance examinations and to make sure that our message reaches out to the far corners of the country we have decided not to charge any examination fees for GVSAT.
